Tips on Recording a Video Interview

Helpful Hints for Shooting Great Video

- 1. When shooting outdoors, keep the sun behind you.
- 2. Plan your shoot.
- 3. MP4 or M4V would be the best format.
- 4. Use a tripod or other image stabilization device, if possible.
- 5. Use the zoom to compose your shot. Avoid zooming while the tape is rolling.
- 6. Keep your average shot length between 20 and 30 seconds.

Helpful Hints for Recording Great Audio

- 1. Get the microphone close to the speaker as possible.
- 2. Keep audio in mind when looking for a location to record at.

Do Not:

- 1. Overuse on-screen zooms.
- 2. Pan all over the scene.
- 3. Forget about Backlighting -- too much light falling on the background instead of on the subject.
