Dr. Meinzer is an Associate Professor in the Department of Psychology and the Director of the Young Adult and Adolescent ADHD Services (YAAAS) Lab at UIC. His research focuses on adverse outcomes (e.g., depression, early pregnancy, substance use, delinquency) that are particularly prevalent among individuals with attention-deficit/hyperactivity disorder (ADHD) during adolescence and early adulthood. Dr. Meinzer is interested in examining the mechanisms behind ADHD and comorbid psychopathology and subsequently developing tailored programming to address these difficulties. He is particularly interested in engaging community partners to adapt and implement tailored programming in non-clinical settings (e.g., schools). Dr. Meinzer also directs the SUCCEEDS Clinic at UIC which provides free, comprehensive care to students with ADHD.
